1. Make sure all Key Stage 1 phonics objectives are secure before moving on.								
2. Read words accurately and fluently without overt sounding and blending, e.g. at over 90 words per minute .								
3. Read some common exception words (Year 3&4).								
4. Sometimes uses dictionaries to check the meaning of words that they have read.								
5. Listening to and discussing a wide range of fiction, poetry, plays, non-fiction and reference books or textbooks.

Reading Fluency	RF1	Make sure all Key Stage 1 phonics objectives are secure before moving on.						
	RF2	Apply their growing knowledge of root words, prefixes and suffixes to some words*						
Comprehension	C1	Increasing their familiarity with a wide range of books, including fairy stories, myths and legends, and retelling some of these orally.						
	C2	Participate in discussion about both books that are read to them and those they can read for themselves, taking turns and listening to what others say.						
	C3	Asking questions to improve their understanding of a text.						
	C4	Preparing poems and play scripts to read aloud and to perform, showing understanding through intonation, tone, volume and action.						
	C5	Recognising some different forms of poetry [for example, free verse, narrative poetry].						
	C6	Understanding of what they read by reading books that are structured in different ways and reading for a range of purposes.						
	C7	Retrieve and record information from non-fiction.						
	C8	Discussing words and phrases that capture the reader's interest and imagination.
