

### **English**

This half term we are going to be reading 'Georges marvellous medicine' and completing lots of character descriptions and alternative endings for the story. As part of a local area topic we will be designing a brochure to promote the key features of our local area. We are also looking at the book 'Greenpeace' and how we can look after our environment.

#### Reading

Please encourage your child to read at least three times a week at home, for at least 15 minutes each time, filling in the date, book title, and page number in your child's new reading journal. Please support your child's understanding of the text by completing the 'learning tools' page once a week.

#### Maths

In maths this half year one will be focussing on their multiplication skills, particularly multiples of 2,5 and 10. If all the children can practice these times tables at home it wold be a big help to them! Year two are also focussing on multiplication and division ensuring that they can share amounts equally. All of the children will be exploring measurement this half term including capacity and units of measurement.

#### Topic - 'Our Locality'

Key stage one are learning about key features in and around Cookridge. Thank you for the photos that have been sent in already of your child in front of a place in our local area. #### Science/ D.T /ICT/Geography

Science: Exploring living things and their habitats. We will be exploring habitats in our local area, and exploring the food chain.

DT-: We will be using different materials to re create different key features that can be found in the area of Cookridge. As part of the optional homework the children have been asked to create a 3D model of a pond which would really help enhance their DT skills.

ICT: Developing our knowledge of digital content, through 'I am learning,' Purple Mash and other programmes.

Geography: We will be looking at the story 'The town mouse and the Country mouse' and using this to compare key features in towns and cities. We will be understand why we have certain features in our local area.

Year 1 and 2 will be continuing to learn to master basic movements in gymnastics, as well as developing balance, agility and co-ordination. Also this term the children will be doing Dance. Please send your child with both indoor and outdoor kit as we will may be going outside for some les-
