Year 5 Trip to Breary Marsh

Dear Parent/Carer,

As Forest Schools is one of the key principles at Cookridge Primary School, on **Tuesday 25**th **June 2019** Year 5 will be spending the majority of the day at Breary Marsh Nature Reserve. Throughout the day, the children will be taking part in a variety of activities, which will link to many areas of the curriculum. This will include: habitat investigations, classification of living organisms, Forest School games to build up resilience, problem solving, drama and storytelling. For more information about the Forest School approach and its aims, please see the school website.

Due to the nature of these activities, children can come to school in their own clothing on the day. The children will be outside for most of the day so they **must** be in comfortable, warm and water proof clothing. The clothing may get dirty and wet, so please do not send children in precious/new clothing. Wellies, walking boots or a sturdy pair of trainers are also recommended. Additionally, children must bring a **packed lunch**, a water bottle and a suitable bag/rucksack to carry them in. If your child is entitled to a free school meal, a packed lunch will be provided by the school. Children may also wish to bring a bag so they can take home items they find in the woods, such as conkers, acorns etc.
