English

For the last half term we will be launching our seaside topic by using the story of 'Billy's Bucket'. We will be using the comedy and imaginative descriptions to develop our own creative writing skills. We will also be looking at holiday brochures. Investigating what the key elements of a holiday brochure include and creating our own.

Reading

Maths

In maths this half term, year one will be beginning by focusing on money. Thinking about the coins and using their reasoning skills to solve problems about money. Year 2 will be finishing their shape topic and moving onto exploring and developing their reasoning and problem solving skills based around measurement and the four operations.

Topic - 'Seaside'

Key stage one will be studying the geographical features of the seaside. We will focus on the he key human and physical features of its surrounding environment and compare it to our own surrounding environment. We will be thinking about why the seaside is a popular holiday destination and comparing the seaside in the UK to those in other countries.

Science/ D.T /ICT/Geography

Science: Exploring Plants. We will be focusing on our working scientifically skills to investigate and explore what different plants need to survive and what the life cycle of a plant looks like.

DT-: We will be looking at where our food comes from and the importance of a healthy and varied balanced diet.
