Reading Comprehension

In Year 2, there is a greater emphasis on a child's reading comprehension. While reading involves translating and decoding text into sounds and spoken words, reading comprehension involves taking what was just read and deriving meaning from those words. In simpler terms, reading comprehension is the ability to read, understand, process, and recall what was just read. Having excellent reading comprehension skills is crucial as it increases the enjoyment and effectiveness of reading, giving them a deeper and better understanding of the text.
