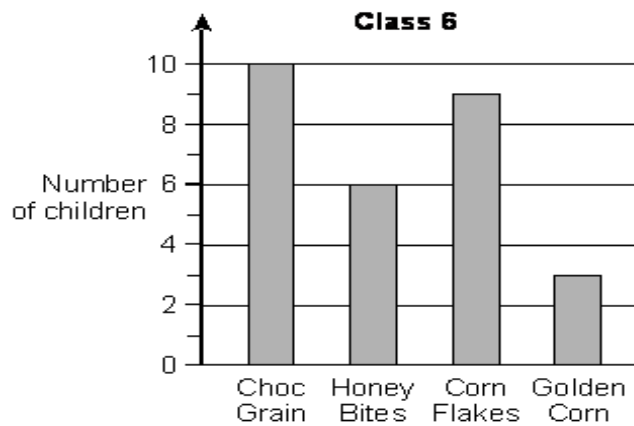

Q15. Tom does a survey of children's favourite breakfast cereals.

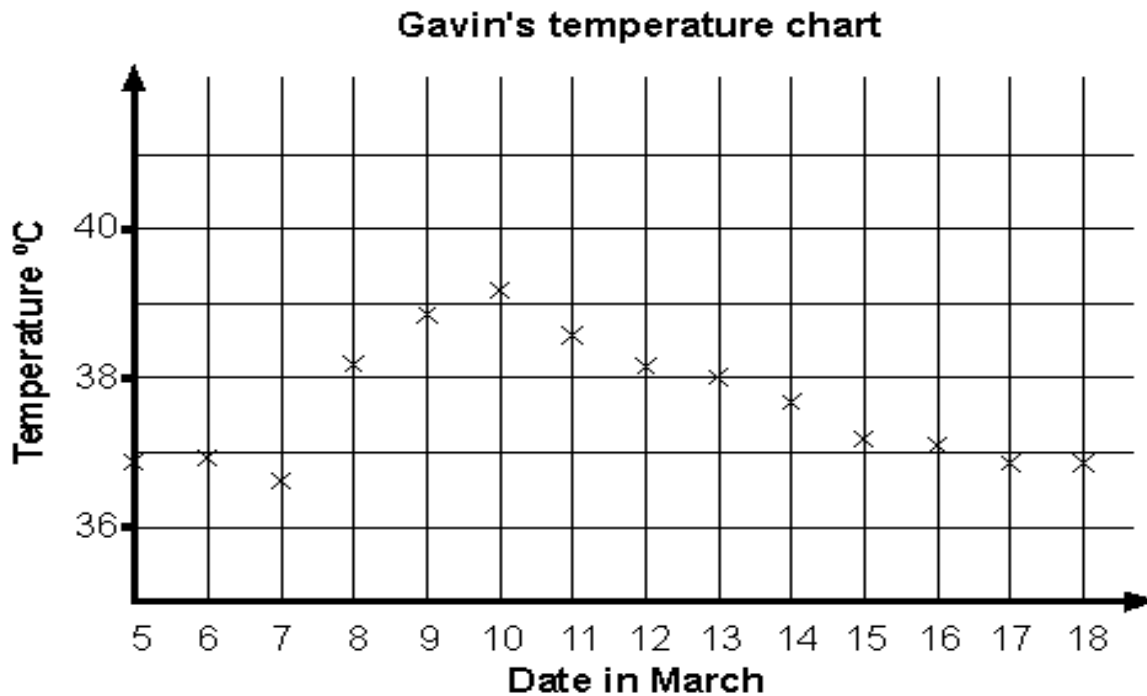
These are the results for Class 6
