English

Children will be using the text 'The Great Nature Hunt' by Claire Hibbert to inspire their writing. Pupils will learn about a variety of animals and the habitats they live in before embarking on a project to create or improve an animal habitat within the school grounds. The project will involve lots of research. teamwork, organisation, skills and knowledge!

Reading

Please encourage your child to read at least three times a week at home, for at least 15 minutes each time, filling in the date, book title, and page number in your child's new reading journal which they will receive soon. Please support your child's understanding of the text by asking questions about what they've read.

Maths

We are looking at number and place value this halfterm in maths and will be learning to compare, order and read and write numbers up to, and beyond, 1000 as well as solving number and practical problems using place value and number skills. Our mental maths focus is on learning our times tables, up to 12x12! Please support your child at home with this challenge.

Topic - Living Things and their Habitats

LKS2's first topic of the year is all about animals and the places they live. Pupils will learn about local and national wildlife and why they live in certain habitats all across the UK. Children will also learn about animal adaptations and how different habitats meet the needs of a wide range of animals. Pupils will also learn about conservation and the dangers animals and habitats face from humans and climate change.

Science/ Art/ D.T /ICT

Science: Living Things and their Habitats: Pupils will be learning that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways and will learn how to use classification keys to help group, identify and name a variety of living things in their local and wider environment. Art: Tone and texture. Pupils will study famous artists drawing of wildlife, including Rembrant and Durer, before designing and creating their own. ICT: Communication and E-safety. This half-term, pupils will learn how to keep safe when using and searching the internet for information and understand how using key
