#### Remember:

Retrieve – the answer is in the text. Circle or underline key words in the question then scan to find them in the text. Read around them to find the answer.

Interpret – the answer may not be in the text and you have to work it out. Use clues in the text and your background knowledge to develop an answer – use evidence to back up your idea if asked to!

Choice – you have to think like an author. Comment on the author's choice of vocabulary or layout and the impact this has on the reader or text.
