Use your arithmetic, written methods and problem solving skills to answer all of the questions. Make sure you turn over!

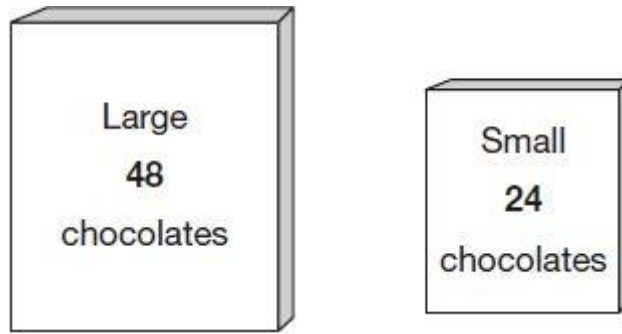
$£182.65 + £67.58 =$	A sticker book can hold 6 stickers per page. If Lucy had 75 stickers, how many pages would she will?
