Challenge 1:

Plants need water to grow. Ask your adult to write different addition sentences on rain clouds. Can you paint/draw the right number of raindrops under each cloud?



Tip: Remember + means to add or find the total of two groups.

Challenge 2:

Plants need sun light to grow. Sun light is great for helping plants but can be dangerous to humans. Can you make a poster about how to be safe in the sun?



Tip: Make sure you segment every word carefully and use your phonics mat to help.

Challenge 3:

Plants need soil to grow. Draw a packet of seeds and a patch of soil. Ask your adult to write a subtraction sentence for you. Put the first number of 'seeds' in your packet. Can you then move the second number of seeds to the soil before counting how many are left in the packet for your answer?
