

'Tricky' words

The words on these pages are exception words that we need to teach to be recognised and read 'on sight'. These words are not phonically regular so cannot be easily decoded by children learning systematic phonics sounds.

Ideas for home:

Try challenging children to recall these words with memory and pairs games. Perhaps hide these words around the house and time how long it takes to find (and read!) them all.
