The child should read the book by decoding and blending each word (or recognizing common exception words) and **talk** through the questions at the end.

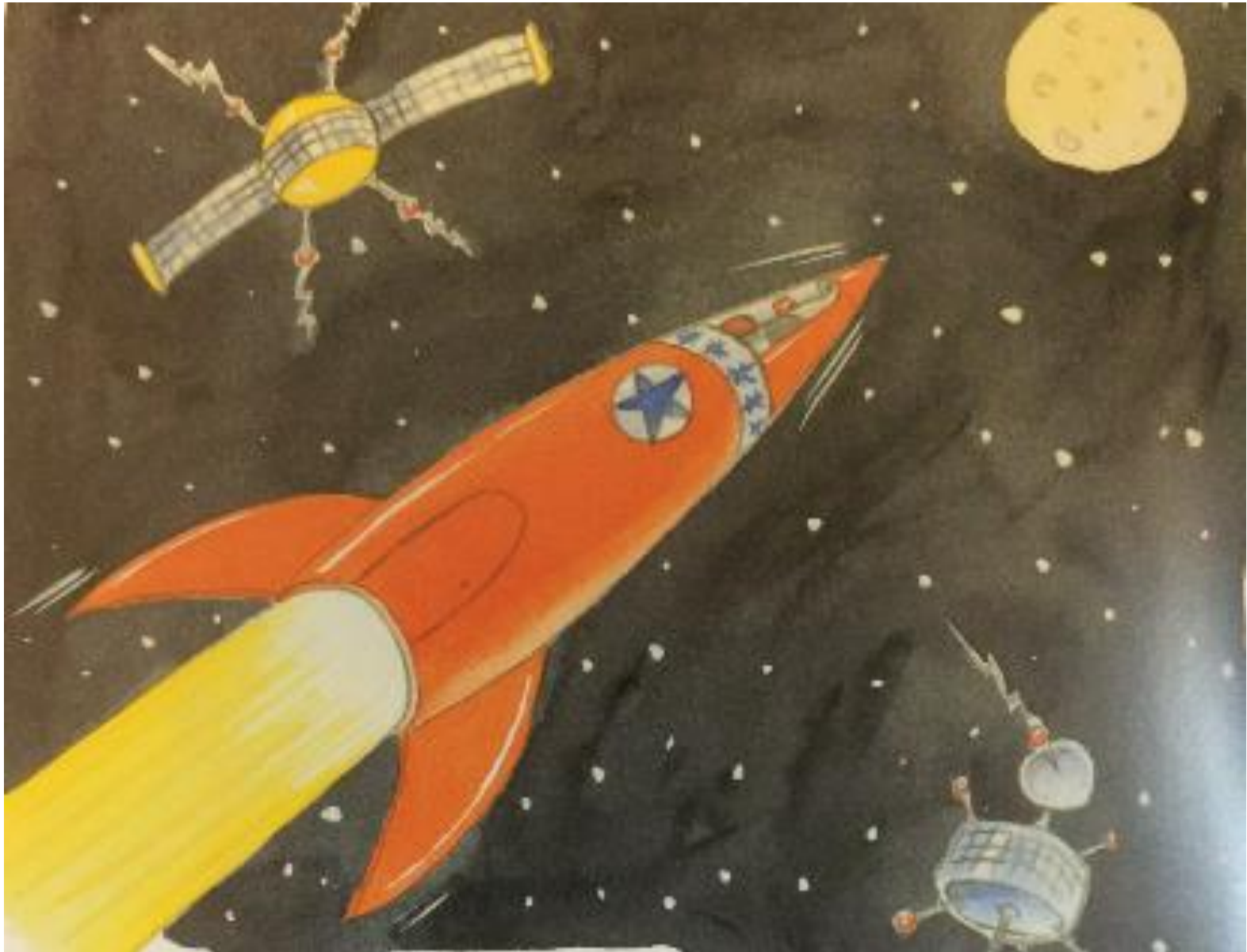


Bot was on a trip to the moon
