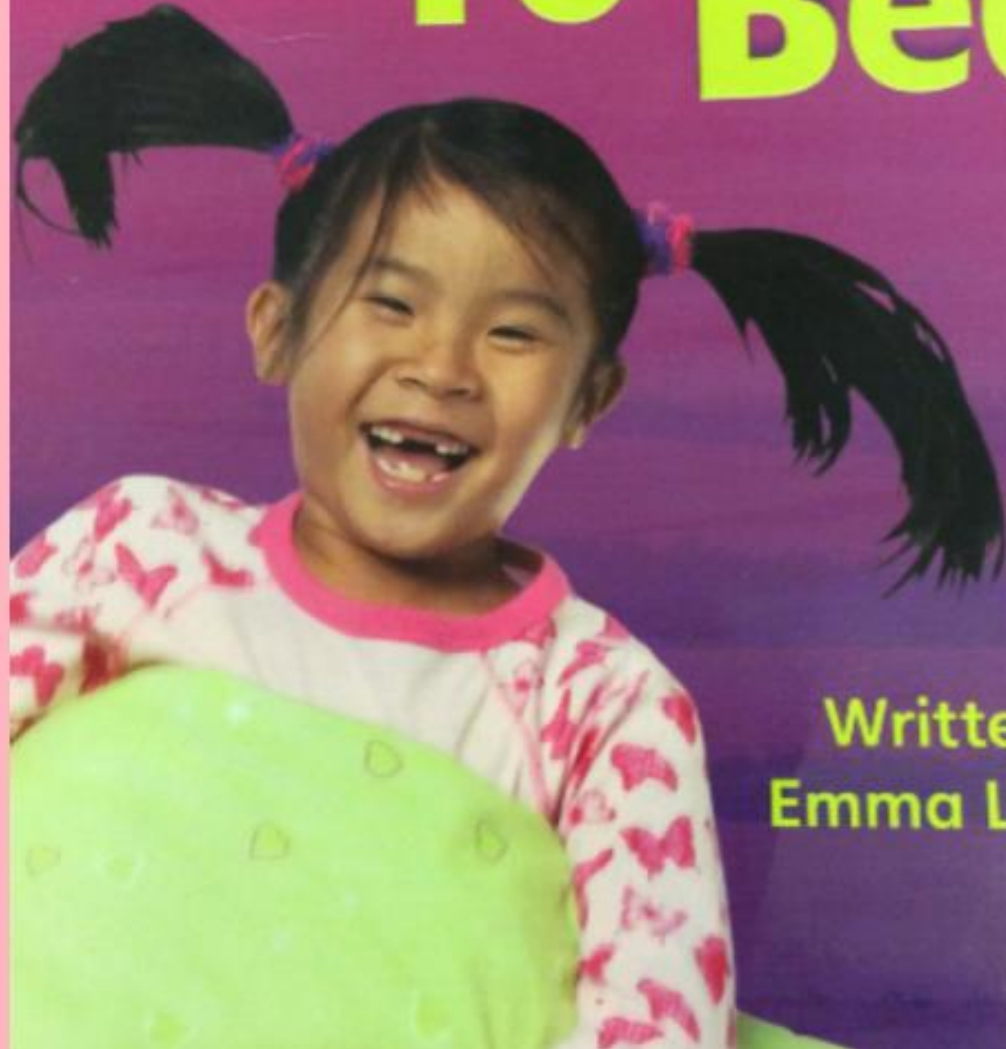
Go To Bed

The child should read the book by decoding and blending each word (or recognizing common exception words) and **talk** through the questions attached at the end.

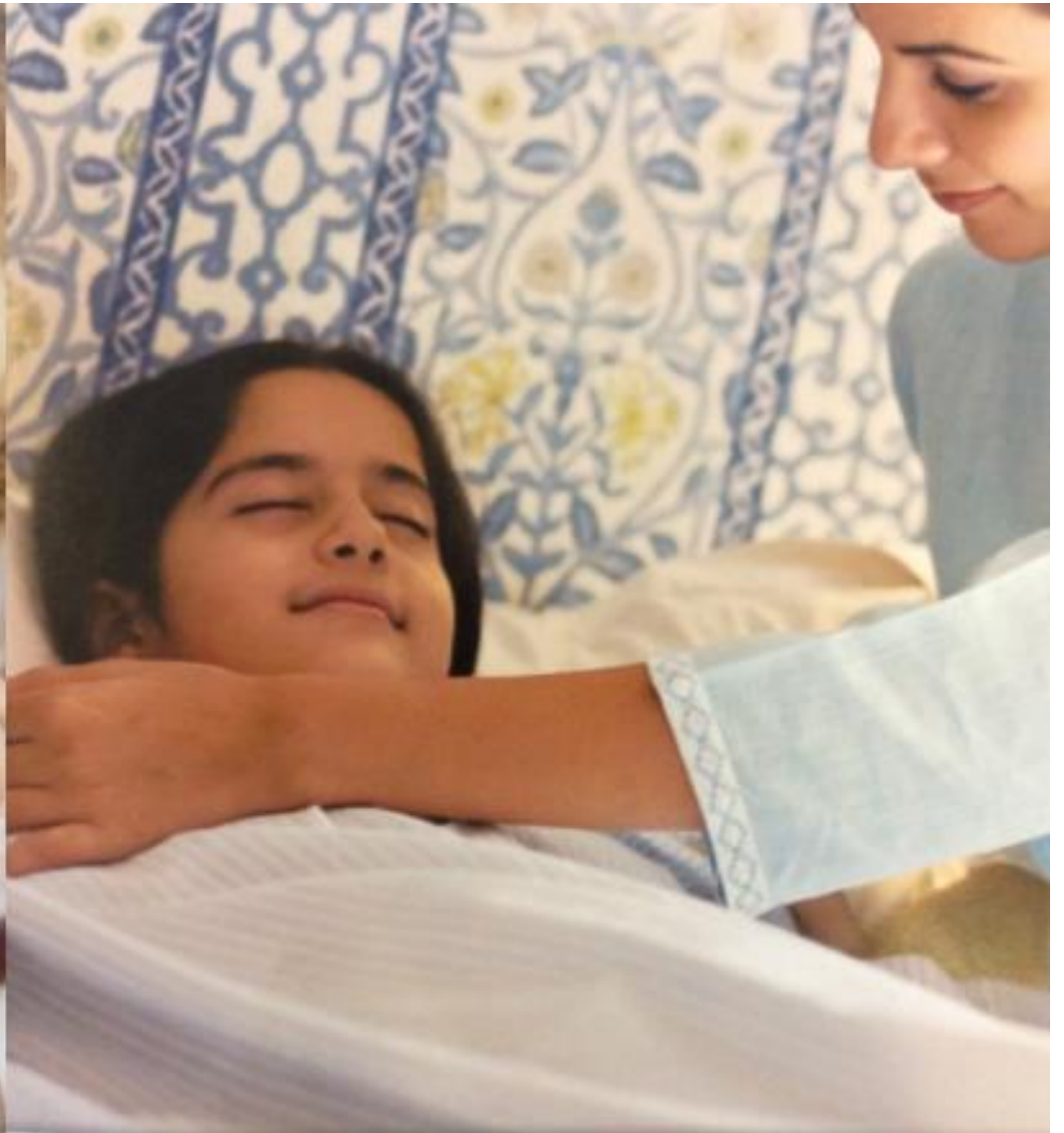

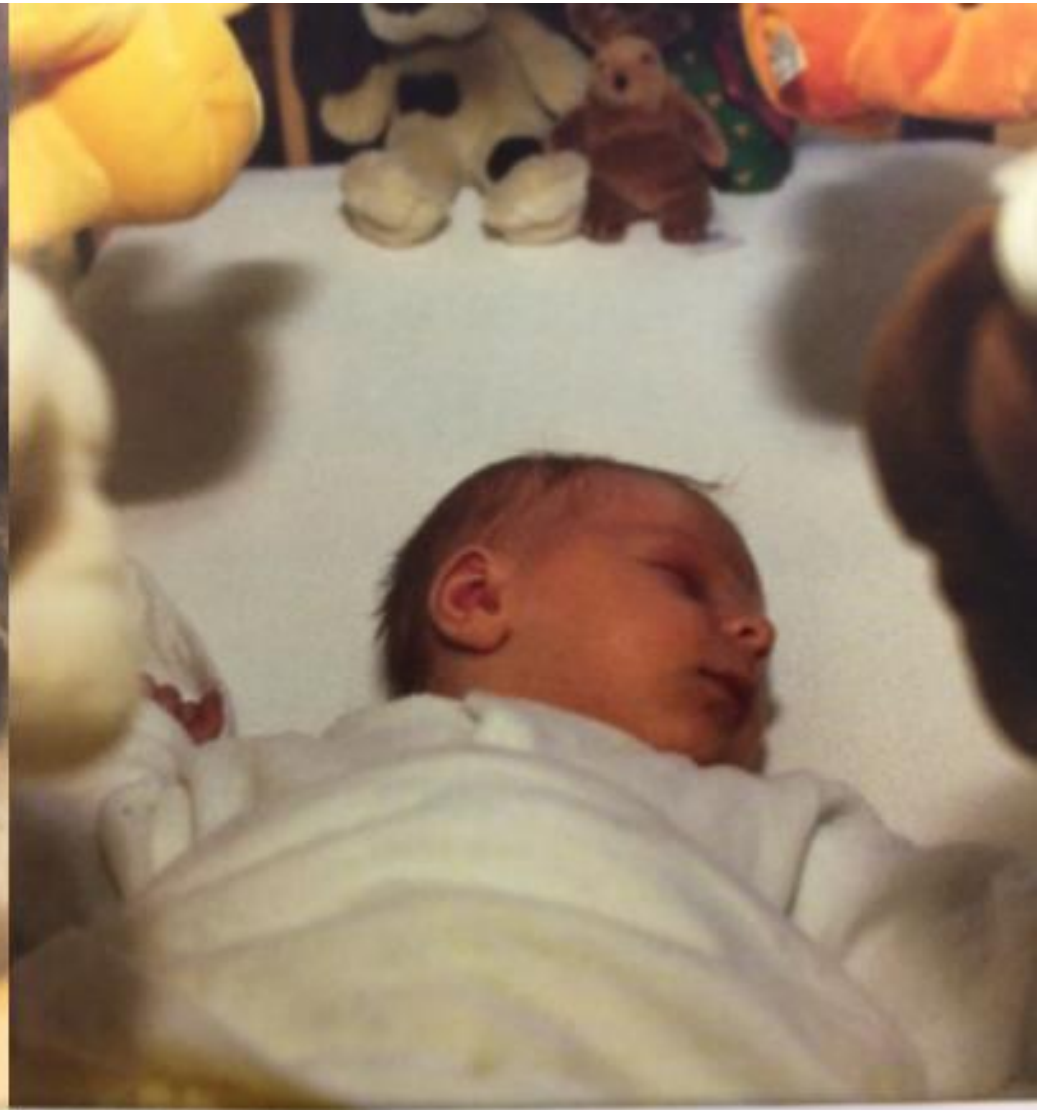
Let's go to bed.
