He had a bubble in his **throat**.



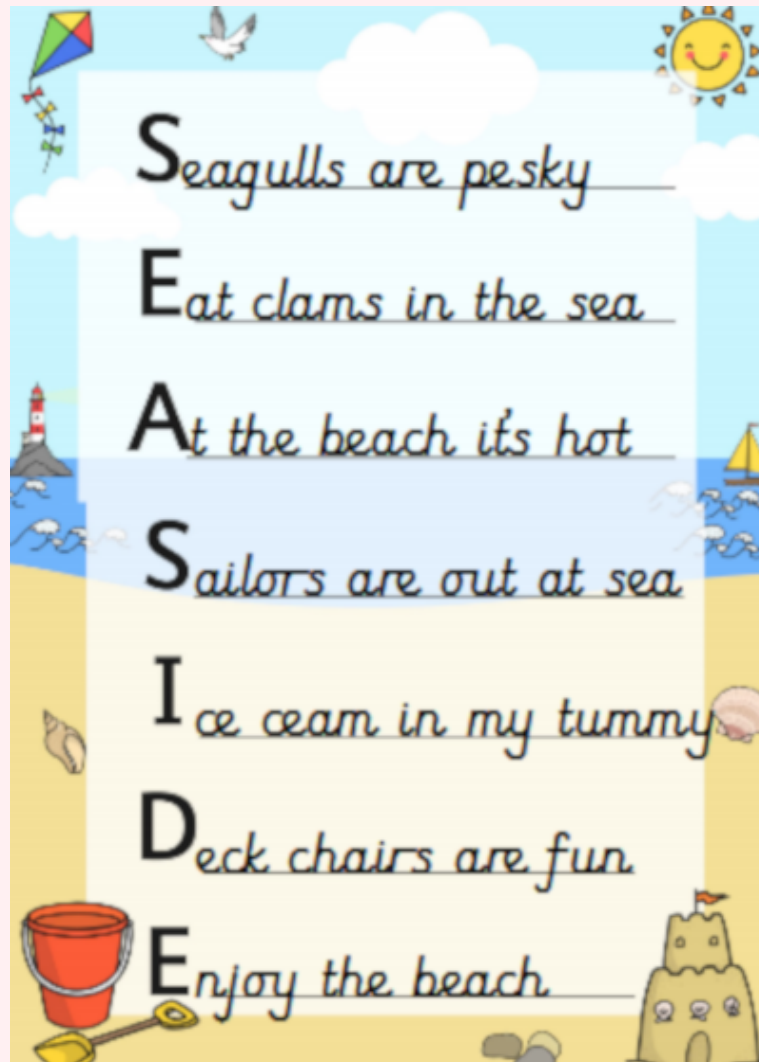






Starfish lullaby

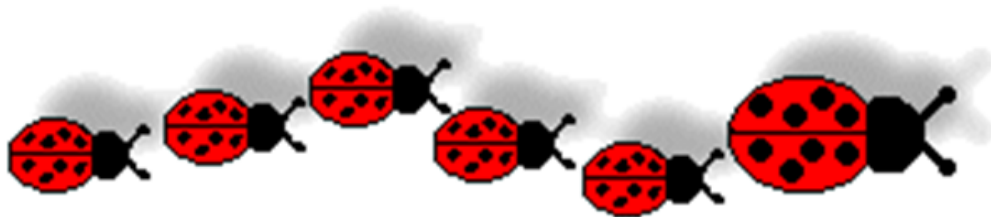
Every night, they wait to see
