#### Focus Learning - Model Example

Step one - identify the correct place value column that the question is asking you to round to.

Step two - look at the digit to the right of that column.

Step three - If the digit is between 0-4, then the digit is left untouched. If the digit is between 5-9 the digit goes up by one.

Step four - Any number of digits after that number becomes a zero.

rounded to the nearest whole number is

9.51

Step one - the number is 9

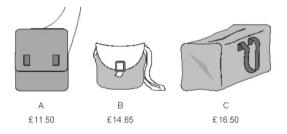
Step two - the number to the right is 5

Step three - as the digit is a 5 that means to round up

Step four - the answer is 10
