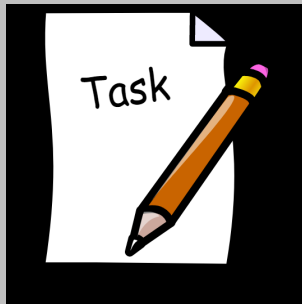
You will now write your *first draft* of the story about making a wish.
