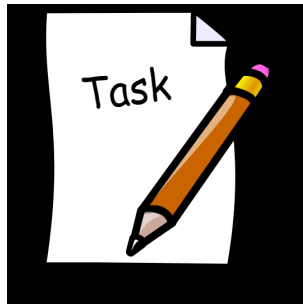
### HELPFUL TIPS
