Spend around 15 minutes editing your story from yesterday. Use the questions below to help you.

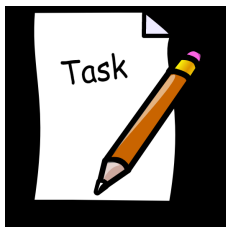
Are there any spellings to correct?

Can you add anything to make it more exciting?

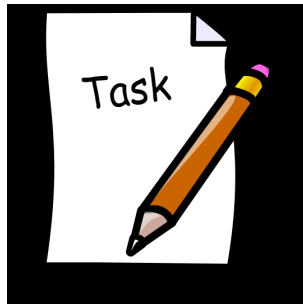
### Final Draft
