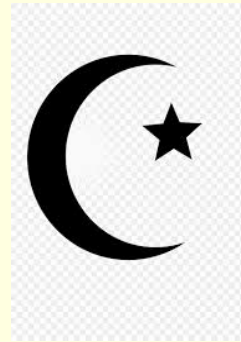
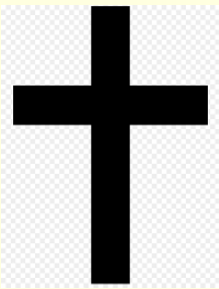
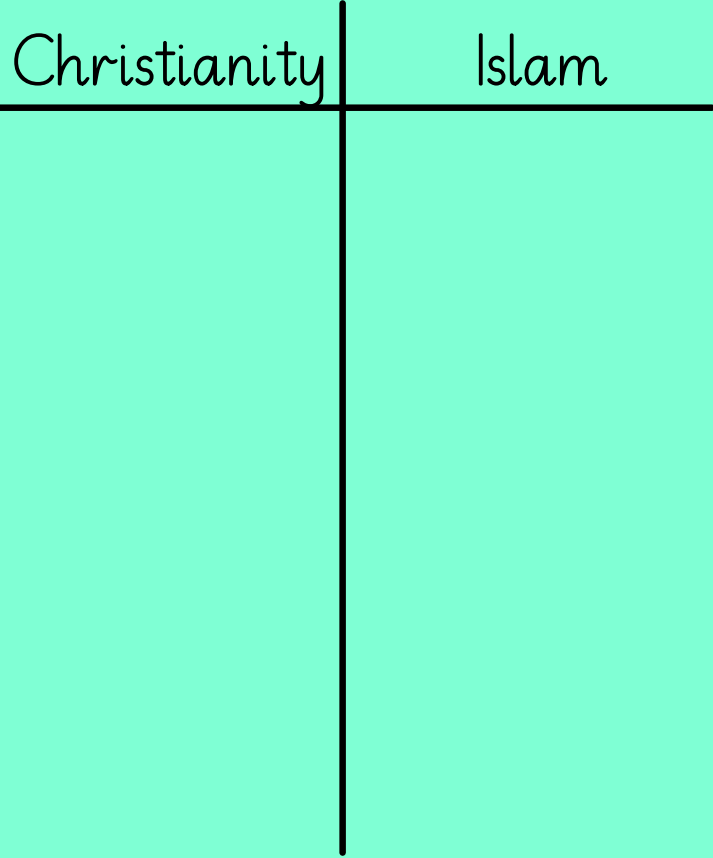


In Key Stage 1 we learn

Christian's go to a church



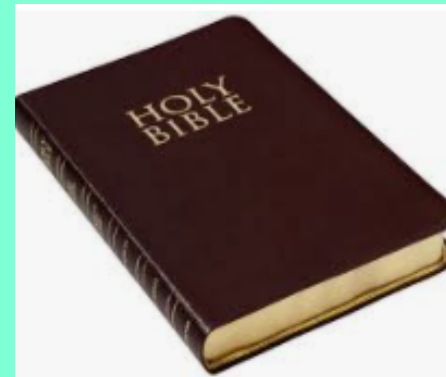
Muslims go to a Mosque

| 5 PILLARS OF ISLAM |          |   |
|--------------------|----------|---|
|                    | SHAHADAH | Belief that there is only one Allah and that Muhammad is Allah's messenger. |
|                    | SALAH    | Prayer and to be given Allah five times each day.                           |
|                    | ZAKAT    | Giving of alms, charity, to the poor, 2.5% of income.                       |
|                    | HAJJ     | Making pilgrimage to the House of Allah in Mecca.                           |
|                    | FASTING  | Fasting (abstain to eat or drink) during the Month of Ramadan.              |

Muslims for the Five Pillars of Islam

These two faiths both place an importance on knowing and loving God above other things.

These two faiths have special celebrations, which often include giving presents, sharing meals and parties with friends and families and the decorating of homes.



Muslims celebrate Eid - This celebration is at the end of the month of Ramadan when Muslims fast



Christians celebrate Christmas - remembering when Jesus was born
