Word Problems

When we solve word problems we must highlight the key information from the question.

Be careful to choose the correct operation.
What is the question asking you to do?

The shop keeper sold apples for 58p. He decreased his price by 24p. How much does an apple cost now?

$$58 - 24 = 34$$

I chose subtraction because it says decrease

Can you solve these word problems by choosing the correct operation?

- 1) The baker sold cookies for 45p. He increased the price by 26p. What is the new price for the cookies?
- 2) A farmer had 2 fields of sheep. One had 68 sheep and the other had 26. How many sheep did he have altogether?
- 3) A book shop was having a sale! Harry Potter was £23 but was reduced by £8. How much is the book now?
- 4) A train had 48 people on it. First, 12 people got off. Then another 13 people got off. How many people are left on the train?
- 5) Harry had 24 stickers, Bob had 18 and Chloe had 16. They put them altogether. What is the new total?
