


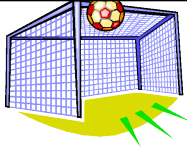

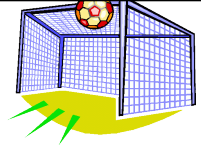

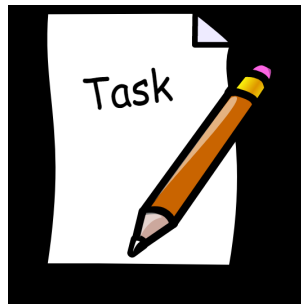

All about Penguins

**What do penguins eat?**  
In the wild, penguins eat fish, shellfish and squid.

**How fast do penguins swim?**  
Some fast swimmers can swim up to 22 miles per hour.

**What do penguins do in the water?**  
They use their wings like flippers, and they can hold their breath for up to 20 minutes per hour.

**What is a group of penguins called?**  
A group of penguins is called a colony.

**What are penguins black and white?**  
Penguins have black feathers on their backs and white feathers on their chests and bellies. This helps them blend in with the dark ocean or the clean snow. From below, the penguins' white bellies are hidden by the bright surface.

**What noise do penguins make?**  
Penguins make a variety of sounds. They make lots of different sounds depending on what they are trying to say.

**How many species of penguins are there?**  
There are thought to be 17 different types, or species, of penguin living in the world today.

**Where do penguins live?**  
Penguins live in 17 cold countries. But all 17 types of penguins do live in the Southern Hemisphere. They cannot be found in the Northern Hemisphere. Outside of Antarctica, penguins tend to live on rocky coastlines or desert regions.

**Do penguins have a mate for life?**  
Yes, most penguins have the same partner for their adult lives. When a male penguin finds a female he will stay with her for the rest of his life. In some species, during breeding season, the same two penguins will pair up again.

**Can you see penguins swimming underwater?**
