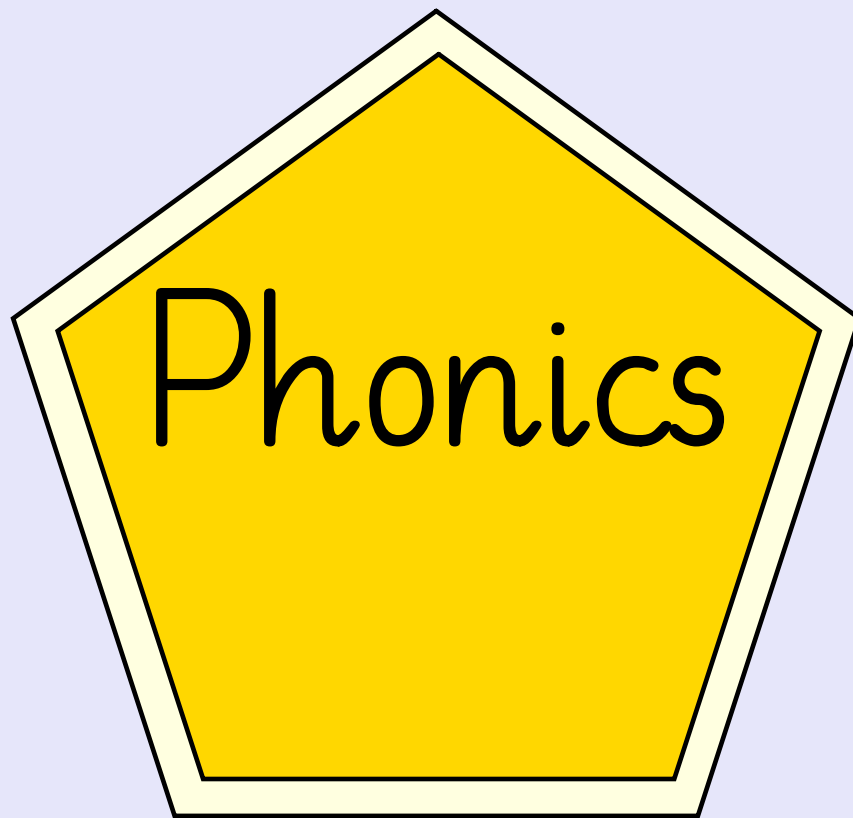

Flash card recap

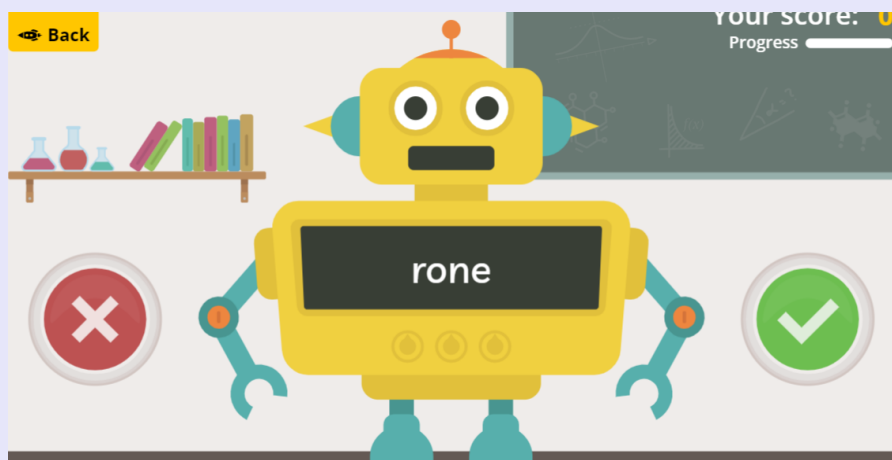

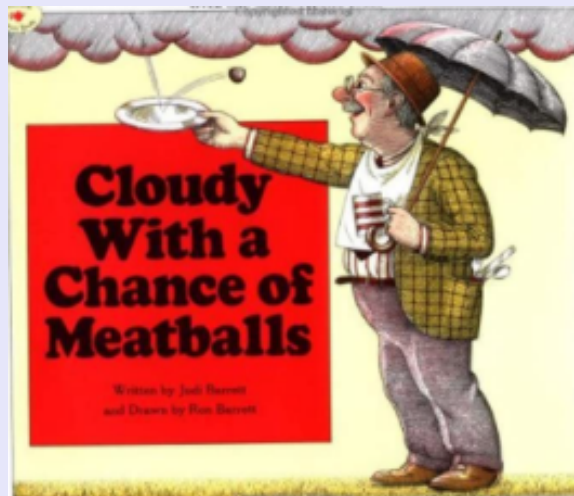

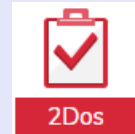
Creative task:
