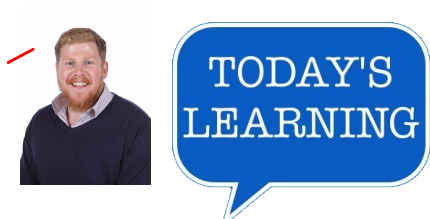


Day 2 Fluency 10
