### What is an Adverb?

An adverb is something that tells you where, why or how something is done. For example:

Camilla crossed the road **safely**.



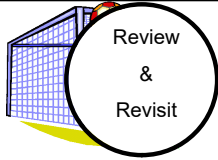
Saffie's horse **bravely** jumped over the hurdle.



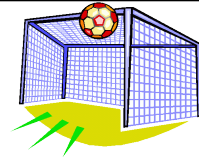
The man drove his car **everywhere**.



Many adverbs end in **-ly** but **not all of them**. Similarly, not all words which end in **-ly** are adverbs.

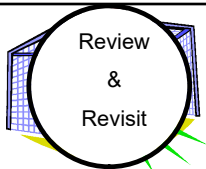

The mysterious stranger walked **happily** down the street.

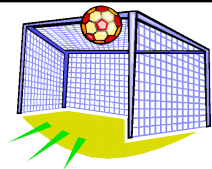
The mysterious stranger walked **angrily** down the street.
