




### Our Learning Objective:

I can orally rehearse my phonics and sentences before writing, whether through role play or other pedagogical approaches.


This week our focus story is going to be 'The Tales of Peter Rabbit.' We will be looking at a story and then producing a piece of writing towards the end of the week














#### Role Play
