
How quickly can you recall all the phase 3 and phase 5 phonemes?






Over the next four days, you will be completing a set of phonics challenges. You will need to use all of the phonemes you have learnt in Year 2.

I can segment spoken words into phoneme and represent these by graphemes, spelling many correctly.




A meteorologist is the name for a person who presents on the weather.


