



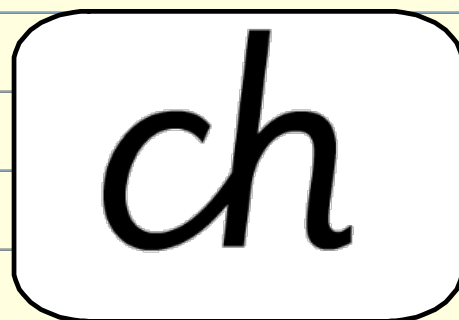

Read the opening page of your challenge booklet to find out the mystery you are going to solve. Complete clues 1 and 2 today.

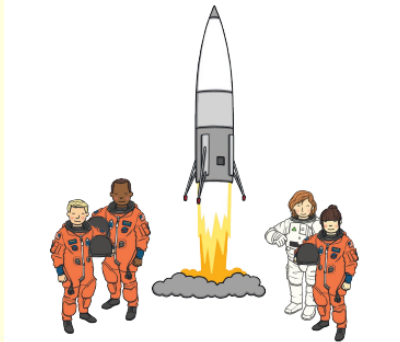
The Mystery of the Astronaut

Many astronauts long to be chosen and a large amount of people have put themselves forward for the job.

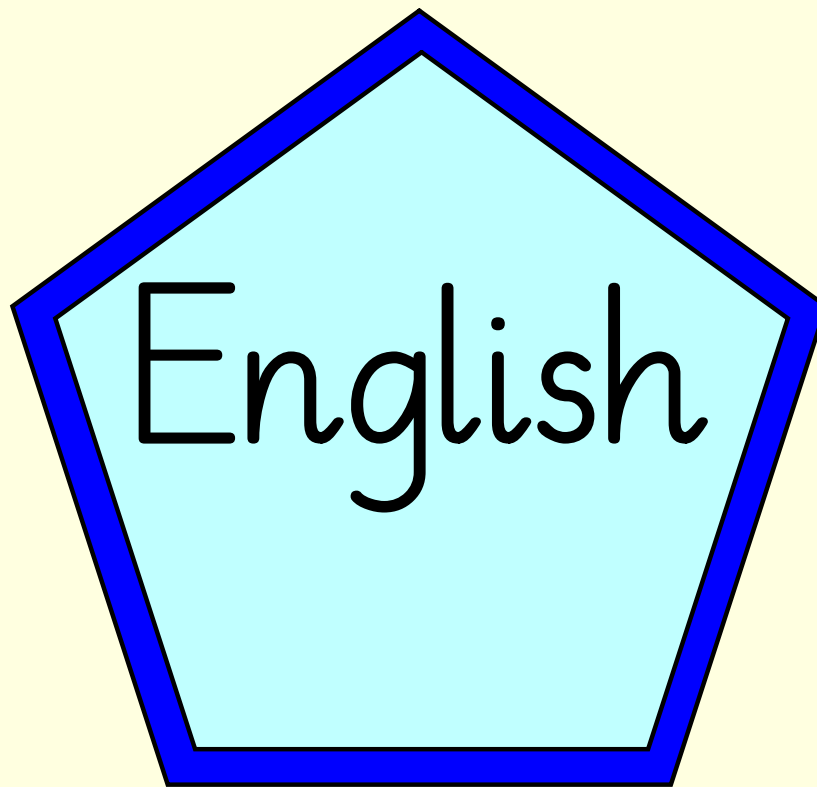
Your task is to solve the clues to work out which astronaut will be chosen.

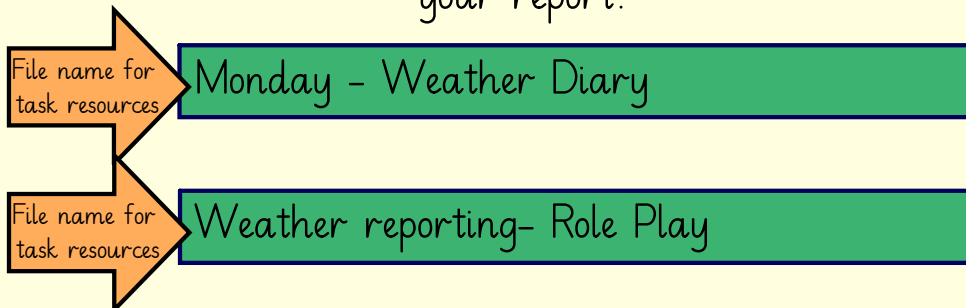

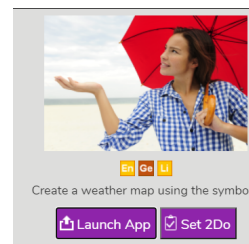
