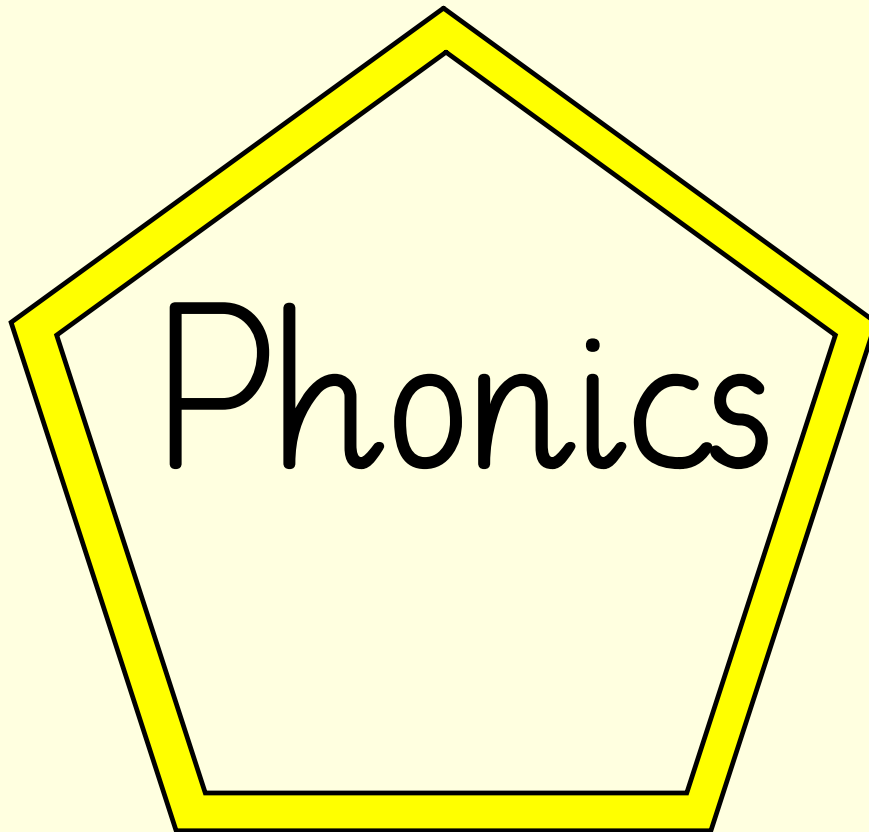

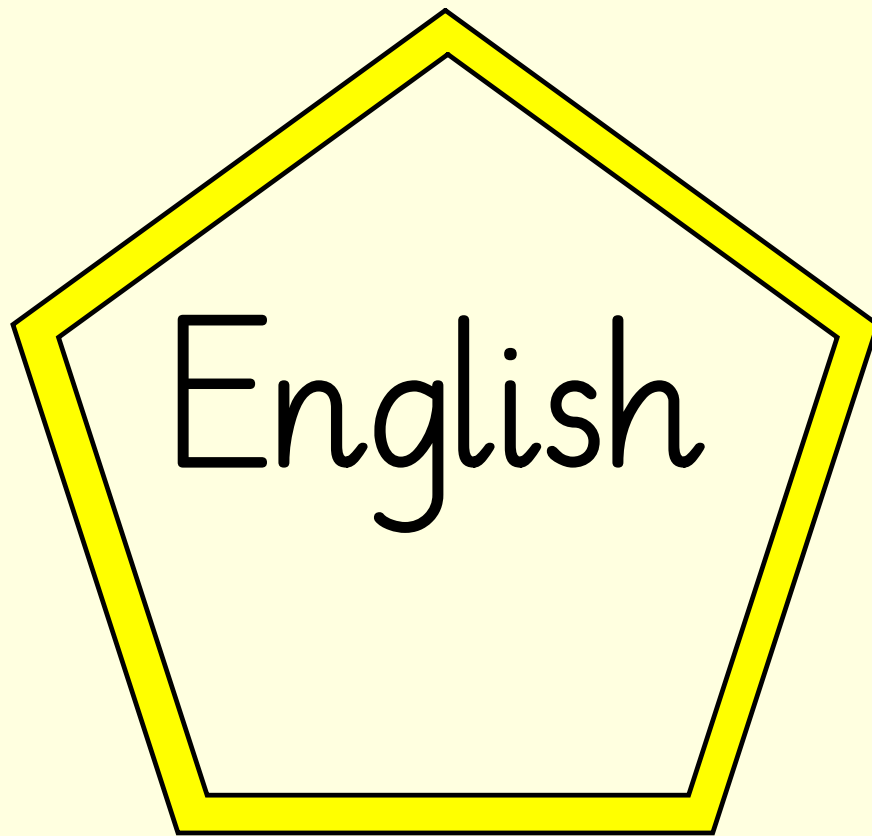
To crack the case, you will need to solve each clue and check the information with the list of names. Will you be able to solve the mystery and find the flowers before the flower parade is over?



