




How to play 'Go

I can use the suffix ending -ed, to change verbs from the present tense to the past tense.


Today we are going to be continuing looking at the suffix ending 'ed' to verbs, but looking at a new spelling rule. Today we are going to be doubling the consonant.



sometimes we have to double the consonant at the end of a word, before we add -ed.

RULE:

In words of one syllable, that end with a single consonant, with a single vowel before it....
