What we'll need:

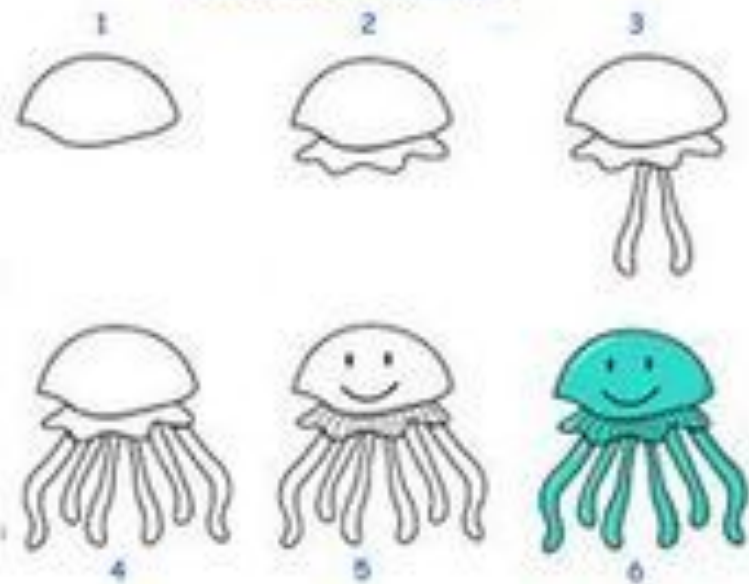
- Pencils

LET'S START!

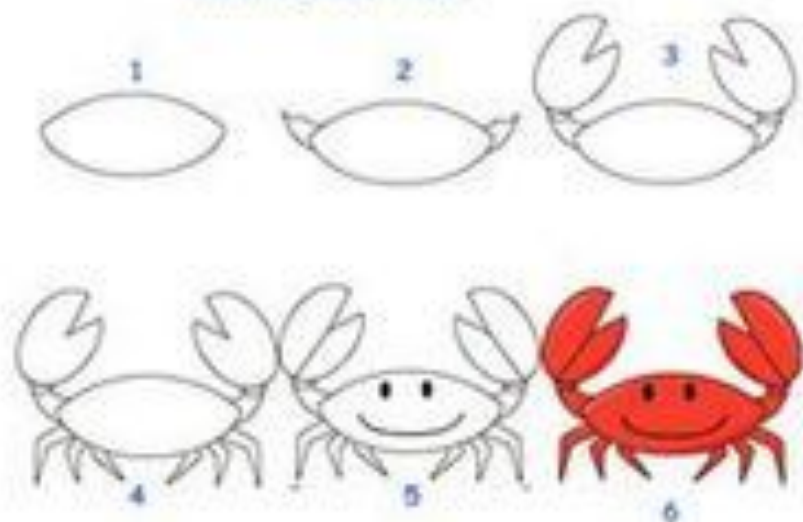
1. On your piece of paper, draw as many sea creatures as you prefer

3. Finally, cut each sea creature out!



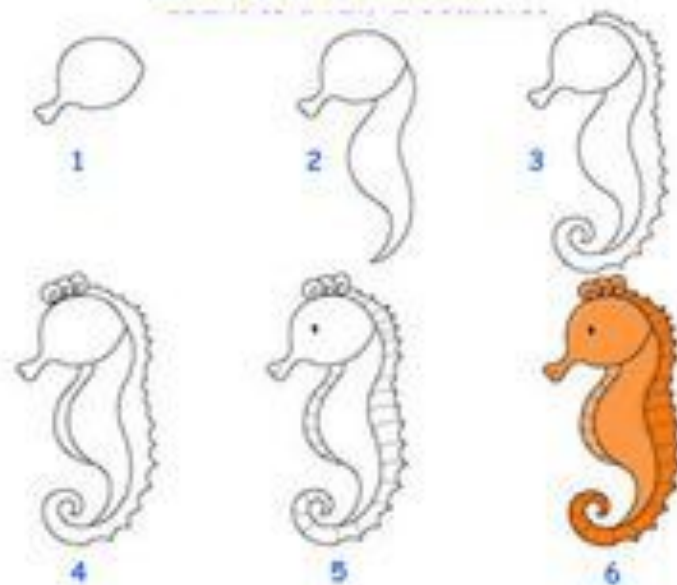

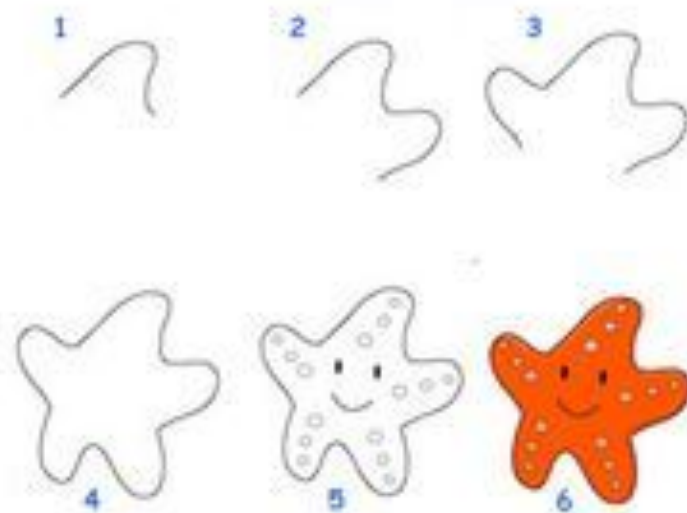
How to Draw a Crab



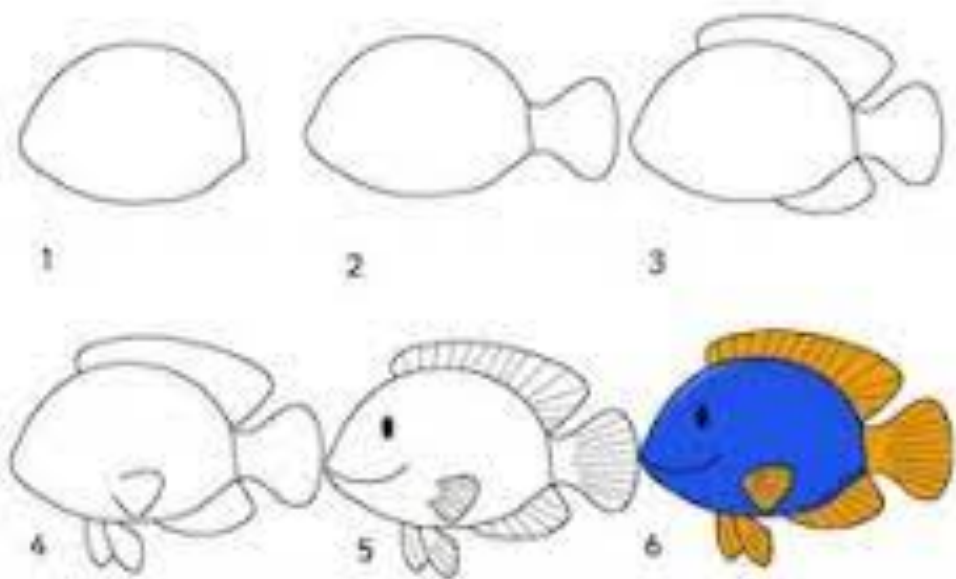
How to Draw a Seahorse



How to Draw a Starfish

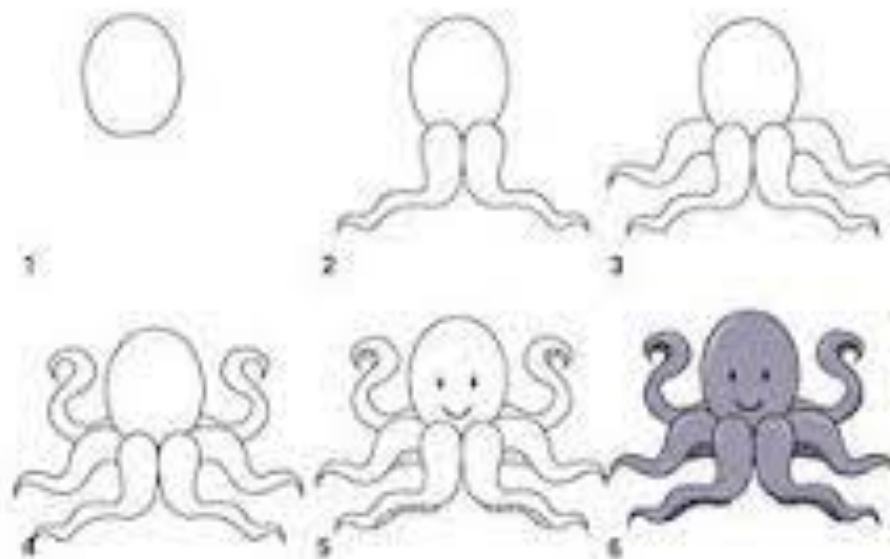

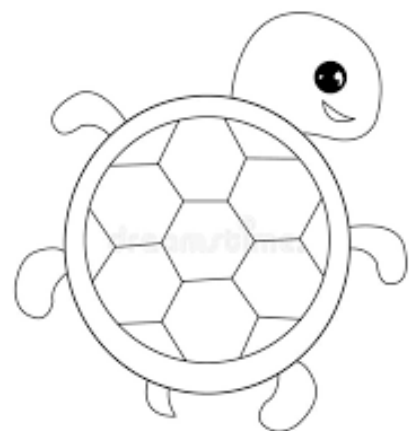

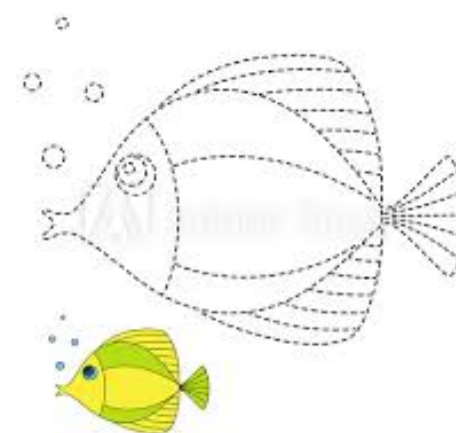
