Welcome to Abbey Grange C of E Academy

We are very excited to be able to open up our academy to parents, carers and children interested in attending in September 2022. We have worked hard to ensure we can provide an opportunity to hear from our Principal, tour the school and speak to some of our amazing staff whilst maintaining levels of social distancing so that everyone can stay safe.

For that reason, we have decided to limit the numbers of people on site during our open evening by allocating tickets to 4 separate sittings. With your ticket, you will be able to listen to a Principal's Welcome, trial some of our fantastic food and get a small experience of what all our subjects offer and do.

In order to minimise numbers so everyone can feel safe, we are restricting our Open Evening only to those parents and pupils who are currently in Year 6. We are restricting the number of tickets per family to 4 but we do request that only the people who need to attend do so. This means that we can maximise the number of potential Y6 children who can come to visit. It also means that visitors can sit themselves apart in our hall and around the academy.

We would ask all visitors to restrict their visit to one hour (15 minutes for Principal's Welcome, 45 minutes looking around the academy)

For those who are still anxious about attending a busy event, the Principal's Welcome will be live

streamed along with other videos of the school and pupils. A virtual tour will be part of this package and a range of resources have been created by our Subject Leaders and Staff so you can also get this experience from the comfort of your own home.

We hope that this offer means we get the best of both worlds – an opportunity for prospective parents and pupils to get a taste of what we do, and to do this is in a safe way where social distancing can be observed.

I would also like to draw attention to parents and carers of our admissions policy. Abbey Grange Church of England Academy is one of the most popular and oversubscribed schools in Leeds. It is also one of the only Church of England schools in the area and putting the academy as first choice does not quarantee a place.

It is also important to note that attending the Open Evening is not a criteria for admission. The admissions policy is implemented independently by Leeds Authority so attendance (or non-attendance) at Open Evening has no influence on this.
