Science	Design and draw a knight. Label which materials you would use for each part of their armour.	Use natural materials from your garden to build a castle. What materials are the strongest?	The drawbridge has broken. Make a boat that floats to get you across the castle moat.
History	Name three Kings and Queens and find out the Years they reined.	Find out 3 facts about our current Queen Elizabeth II.	Choose a King or Queen and create a fact file about them.
Geography	Name 3 Castles in the United Kingdom.	Draw where the 3 castles are located on a map of the British Isles.	Create a map of the British Isles and name the surrounding seas. This can be a drawing or a model made from cardboard, lego etc.
Art/DT	Draw a castle and label the key features.	Design your own coat of arms to go on a shield. You can include things you like or things to do with your family.	Make a 3D castle out of a material of your choice- cardboard, lego etc.
