

## Extra-curricular Sports Clubs 2021/22

Premier Sport is pleased to announce that they will be running a Multi Skills club for KS1 and Football clubs for KS2 children at Cookridge Primary School.

Children will be learning social skills, having great fun with friends and also learning the key attributes needed to develop and excel in sports.

The children in Multi-Sports will learn key skills from a variety of different sports as well as gaining knowledge on the rules and tactics of a variety of different fun and engaging games.
