Science	Write a fact file about one planet in our solar system.	Build a model of one of the planets. Can you label it with facts?	Create your own periscope.
History	Draw a timeline of the Space Race.	Write a short biography about Neil Armstrong, Buzz Aldrin or Michael Collins.	Create your own space quiz with a historical focus.
Geography	On a world map, label the different space agencies for each continent.	Use compass points to help you identify the constellations in the night sky.	Using physical features to support your argument, write a persuasive leaflet to identify which other planet humans could live on.
Art/DT	Make a puppet to perform a shadow puppet show to someone at home.	Draw the planets in proportion and in the correct order from the sun, using an art media of your choice.	Re-create a model of Apollo 11.
