### **English**

This term we will be focusing on a variety of genres including poetry using the Singing Mermaid as our inspiration alongside the Three Little Pirates and the classic novel Peter Pan

We will be reading a class book to promote a love of reading and continuing to develop or fluency, phonics and spelling skills.

### Maths

In Maths this term we are focusing on Multiplication and Division with lots of practical outdoor activities. This will combine with fluency activities to embed addition and subtraction knowledge from last term. We encourage the children to explain and reason how they got their answers and work on problem solving tasks to deepen their knowledge of Maths.

### Reading

Please encourage your child to read at least three times a week at home, for at least 15 minutes each time. We will be sending reading records home again for you to comment on your child's reading.

Reading books can be changed daily.

We are continuing to focus on phonics and learn new sounds. Year one are moving onto phase 5 sounds and year two are focusing on alternative sounds and spellings.
