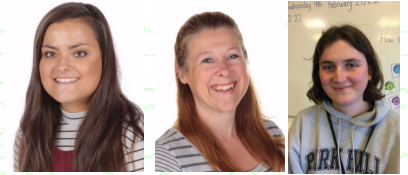

This term we will be focusing on a variety of genres including information texts and alternative story versions using , Meerkat Mail, African stories and non fiction books. We will be reading a class book to promote a love of reading and continuing to develop or fluency, phonics and spelling skills.

Maths

In Maths this term we are consolidating all the Maths knowledge from previous terms. We will be covering Time, Position and Direction, Fractions, Money and Statistics. We encourage the children to explain and reason how they got their answers and work on problem solving tasks to deepen their knowledge of Maths.

Reading

Please encourage your child to read at least three times a week at home, for at least 15 minutes each time. We will be sending reading records home again for you to comment on your child's reading.

We are continuing to focus on phonics and revise sounds learn throughout the year. Year one will be taking the Year One Phonics screening test the week of 6.6.22. Year Two are focusing on alternative sounds and spellings and applying these in their writing.

Yr 2- How do you recognize our feelings?

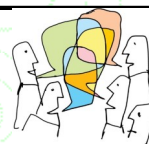
