This allows time for staff to see the children home before the fair starts. The children who are not being picked up early, will still visit the summer fair with their teacher and there will be an opportunity for them to bring some money in for the occasion, these children will then be picked up at 3:05pm as usual. The summer fair will continue until 3:30pm. There will be a form to complete nearer the time to notify us if you will be picking your child up early or not on this day.

As ever, we need the support of our amazing parents to help with this so we are asking for the following donations to be brought on certain days. The children will be rewarded with teams points and extra play times for the items they bring in.

Monday 11th July: **Bottles – 5 team points for every item**
