



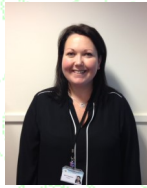

English

This term we will be focusing on a variety of genres. We will begin by reading Colour Monster which is linked to our PSHE objectives and feelings. We will then be reading 'Gunpowder plot' and 'Festivals' and seasonal stories. We will continue to have a specific focus on phonics and reading, to develop fluency skills.

Maths

In Maths this term we are focusing on addition and subtraction with lots of practical outdoor activities. Also a focus on correctly forming their numbers and writing them in words. We encourage the children to explain and reason how they got their answers and work on problem solving tasks to deepen their knowledge of Maths.

Reading

Please encourage your child to read at least three times a week at home, for at least 15 minutes each time. Your child will be given a reading diary, we encourage you to make notes about your child's reading. These will be checked regularly. Books can be changed daily.

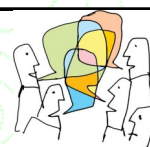
