History	Find out and write down three facts about Julius Caesar.	Draw a map of a roman town, including the features which made it so advanced.	Can you write a paragraph comparing Roman life to life in the Neolithic period?
Geography	Which three cities in Europe have the largest population?	Label the world map with the following:  <i>Lines of latitude, longitude, Equator, Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere</i>	Write a paragraph comparing Leeds with a different city in Europe.
Art/DT	Draw and label a picture of a roman soldier, including the main features of their armour.	Make a roman shield out of recycled materials.	Can you design and create a mosaic out of different materials in your home?
