This term we will be focusing on a variety of genres, both narrative and non-narrative.

Year One will be making a brochure for Bridlington, Looking at a biography for a poet and writing a narrative using 'Dear Green Peace'.

Year Two will be writing a non-narrative piece using 'Dear Green peace' and a narrative using 'The Lighthouse Keeper's lunch'.

Maths


