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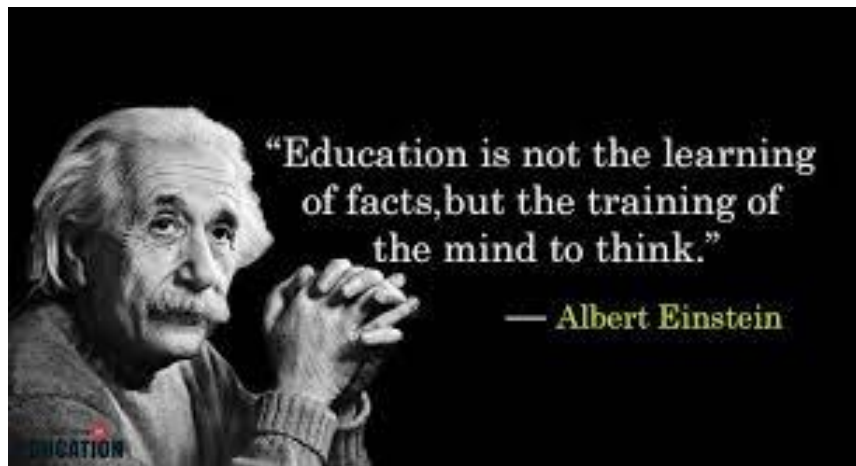

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SATs Timetable – Year 6 – May 2023

As you are aware all children will be taking their SATs test this year. They are a statutory part of the curriculum and they will assess the children's understanding in Maths, SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) and Reading.

Below is a breakdown of when the tests will be carried out. All tests will be carried out in the mornings.

Tuesday 9 th May 2023 09/05/2023	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar Test (SPaG) (Paper 1) Spelling Test (Paper 2)
Wednesday 10 th May 2023 10/05/2023	Reading Paper
Thursday 11 th May 2023 11/05/2023	Maths – Paper 1 – Arithmetic Maths – Paper 2 – Reasoning
Friday 12 th May 2023 12/05/2023	Maths – Paper 3 - Reasoning

Any support you can provide for your child in the run up to their assessments is greatly appreciated by all of the Year 6 team.

It is vitally important that pupils have a good night's sleep and arrive at school on time each day. If your child wears glasses, please ensure they bring them to school each day.

As always, we will be holding our breakfast club in class. The children will be provided with a range of breakfast cereals, toasts/bagels and fruit to help them ensure they are prepared fully for their assessments.

The children should arrive at school at the usual time for registration and line up as they normally would at the top gate.
