Year 5 – Lineham Farm Residential

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have organised an autumn residential for Year 5 next academic year (2023-2024). This is a fantastic opportunity for pupils to visit Lineham Farm. Since 1993 Lineham Farm has been enhancing the lives of local children by providing much needed respite breaks and activity holidays.

The trip will take place from **Wednesday 27th September 2023 to Friday 29th September 2023**. Your child will enjoy three days and two nights at Lineham Farm. It's a well-known activity centre with fully trained instructors, all equipment is provided and a thoroughly jam-packed agenda across the three days includes both indoor and outdoor activities organised for the children - nightline, orienteering, bushcraft, archery and problem solving tasks to name but a few! Many schools within Yorkshire and in particular Leeds use the centre. The cost of the trip - full board – is £130. For those children who are pupil premium, the cost will be £65. If you are unsure whether your child receives the pupil premium grant, please contact the school office. This cost includes transport, accommodation, all meals, equipment and activities. If you would like your child to attend then we must receive **a deposit of £20 by Friday 20th July 2023**. The payment of the deposit will book your child's place on the residential. Full payment can be paid as the year progresses.

We will be using Parent Pay to pay for the residential. There will be a specified section named 'Lineham Farm' and money can be paid directly to the school through this. Using this will allow you to make payments as and when possible, as well as allowing you to easily see the outstanding balance.

We have worked hard to ensure the cost of the trip is as minimal as possible and would love as many pupils as possible to come. We believe it is a fantastic way to start UKS2 and a great opportunity to build a positive relationship with their new teachers.

Please have a look at the news post on your child's class page where you will see some information slides about the residential too. **I have scheduled an online meeting (via Zoom) for Tuesday 20th June @ 5pm** where I will go through the slides and answer any questions you may have.
