English

Over this half-term, we will be using the book 'What Darwin Saw' as inspiration for our writing. We will be creating our own diary entries as if we are Darwin and keeping records of our findings. Following this, we will be creating narratives about Amazonian tribes living unfound in the depths of the jungle.

We can't wait to see what amazing stories our children create this half term!

Maths

In Spring, we will be moving on to one of the biggest areas of maths—fractions, decimals and percentages! The pupils will be calculating with fractions, converting from improper fractions to mixed numbers and finding fractions of amounts, including shape!

To have a good understanding of fractions, it is vital that pupils know their times tables inside out!

Forest School

This term, we will be having a Forest School day every Monday (this is both Week 1 and Week 2). Pupils must attend school wearing suitable outdoor clothing (not school uniform) for the whole day. During the spring term we will be using our fire lighting skills to celebrate 'Brew Monday' by creating a variety of warm beverages. In addition to this, pupils will be tree planting as part of national tree week!

Topic: South America

This half-term we leave our Ancient Greece topic behind and move on to the very exciting topic of South America! We can't wait to dive in to exploring the Amazon rainforest and study the impact this resource has had on the world. We will also be studying how ancient civilizations of South America lived and what similarities and differences they may have with how we live in Britain today!

Science/French/Computing/RE

Our new science topic this half-term is 'Evolution and Inheritance'. We will be exploring how living things have changed over time and using Darwin's journey to look at his theory of evolution.

In French, our topic is 'School Life.' As part of this we will talk about the variety of subjects that we learn. We will also look at how we can ask for everyday items around school.

In computing, we will be using InO-Bots to design, write and de-bug programmes.
