English

Over this half-term, we will be developing our knowledge and understanding of environmental issues within South America. Students will be writing a letter explaining these issues, as well as offering solutions to these problems. Following this, we will be creating narratives about being a tribe member from one of the Amazonian tribes!

Maths

This half term, we will be developing our reasoning skills across a number of topics. This will include; perimeter, area and volume, as well as translation, reflection and enlarge-

It is vital that pupils continue to know their times tables inside out, as this will help with the fluency activities in lesson. Please continue to use TTRock Stars at home!

Forest School

This term, we will be having a Forest School day every Monday (this is both Week 1 and Week 2). Pupils must attend school wearing suitable outdoor clothing (not school uniform) for the whole day.

During this half term, pupils will be working on different knot types to help them create their own outdoor dens, as well as using them to safely put up hammocks!

Topic: South America

This half-term we will continue with our exciting topic of South America! We will be looking at key inspirational individuals that have had an impact on South America, including Pelé. We will continue to explore the different countries that make up South America, including Brazil, Peru, Chile and Uruguay, as well as further developing our understanding of some of the traditions found within this wonderful continent.

Science/French/Computing/RE

Our topic this half-term continues to be 'Evolution and Inheritance'. We will be running a number of interactive lessons to further develop our understanding of how living things produce offspring of the same kind, but can vary and are not identical to their parents. The pupils will even be trying to sort out the UKS2 into their family groups from a range of photos!
