- All children will then complete a 'wish list' based on what they have seen and bring this wish list home with them.
- Parents can then check the wish list with their child and discuss their chosen book(s).

- This will also be sent out via the app for easier access.
- The payment link expires at 12:00pm on Friday 15th March. Unfortunately, no payments can be accepted after this time.
- Finally, pupils **must return the wish list to school** where the purchase will be verified and the book sent home.
- If copies of popular books run out, then these will be ordered by school through Scholastic and there will be a short delay in you receiving the book(s) purchased for your child.

World Book Day tokens, worth £1, can be redeemed off the price of any book at the fair. Please indicate if you are using one on the wish list by indicating this in the gift voucher area of the wish list then return the voucher with the wish list to school.
