



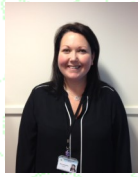

### English

This term we will be looking at Bridlington Brochures and reading *The Lighthouse Keeper's lunch*. We will practise reading fluency but will continue to have a greater focus on our comprehension skills and understanding of what we are reading.

### Reading

Please encourage your child to read at least three times a week at home, for at least 15 minutes each time. Reading records will continue to be sent home for you to comment on your child's reading.

Reading books can be changed daily.



### Maths

In Maths this term we are continuing to practice multiplication and division (2s, 5s, 10s) whilst beginning to look at measure, geometry and statistics. We continue to encourage the children to explain and reason how they got their answers and work on problem solving tasks to deepen their mathematical understanding.

### Friendly reminders

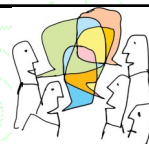
