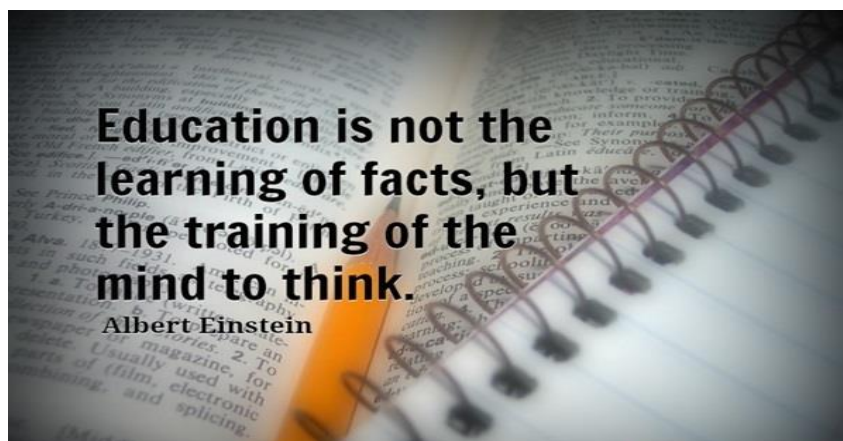

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## **SATs Timetable – Year 6 – May 2025**

As you are aware all children will be taking their SATs next week. They are a statutory part of the curriculum and they will assess the children's understanding in Maths, SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) and Reading.

Below is a breakdown of when the tests will be carried out. All tests will be carried out in the mornings.

Monday 12 <sup>th</sup> May 2025 12/05/2025	Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar Test (SPaG) (Paper 1)  Spelling Test (Paper 2)
Tuesday 13 <sup>th</sup> May 2025 13/05/2025	Reading Paper
Wednesday 14 <sup>th</sup> May 2025 14/05/2025	Maths – Paper 1 – Arithmetic Maths – Paper 2 – Reasoning
Thursday 15 <sup>th</sup> May 2025 15/05/2025	Maths – Paper 3 - Reasoning

Any support you can provide for your child in the run up to their assessments is greatly appreciated by all of the Year 6 team.

It is vitally important that pupils have a good night's sleep and arrive at school on time each day. If your child wears glasses, please ensure they bring them to school each day.

As always, we will be holding our breakfast club in class. The children will be provided with a range of breakfast cereals, toasts/bagels and fruit to help them ensure they are prepared fully for their assessments. Pupils should also have breakfast at home.

The children should arrive at school at the usual time for registration and line up as they normally would at the top gate.
