Science	List the main things a plant needs to survive	Find a flower in your garden, the park or near your house. Can you draw it and label the parts?	Create a presentation explaining the life cycle of a plant. You can present it how you like - a powerpoint, a poster, photographs...
History	Can you find out the name of the oldest building in Europe? If you can, look it up and have a go at drawing it!	Write at least 8 sentences using some of our key words: invasion conquer empire reign rule	Why was the French Revolution so important? Have a go at answering this question in a paragraph, using knowledge from your history lessons as well as your own research.
Geography	Write down as many European countries as you can remember. Try not to use a map or the internet!	List 6 European landmarks, including the country where they are found. Can you draw pictures of them?	Choose 5 food items from your kitchen. Can you see on the label where the food came from? Which foods travelled the furthest?
Art/DT	Choose a country and sketch its flag.	Find some scrap material at home. Draw the outline of a country and have a go at cutting it out!	Can you use recycled materials to build a European landmark?
